Best-selling author Anne Perry to speak at Fayetteville Public Library

New York Times best-selling mystery author Anne Perry is the keynote speaker for Fayetteville Public Library's 2017 Summer Author Series.

"The Art of Storytelling: An Evening with Anne Perry" will take place Tuesday, June 13 at 6 p.m. at Fayetteville Public Library. The author will discuss her writing process and work. Perry will also take audience questions.

A signing will follow her talk. Books will be available for purchase in the library's lobby.

Anne Perry is best known for her historical detective fiction series set in Victorian England: the Charlotte and Thomas Pitt novels, which include "Dorchester Terrace" and "Midnight at Marble Arch," and for her William Monk novels featuring "A Sunless Sea" and "Blind Justice." She is also the author of a series of five World War I novels, fourteen holiday novels and a historical novel, "The Sheen on the Silk," set in the Ottoman Empire.
